Enclosed you will find an application for Rebuilding Together Quad Cities, formerly Hearts and Hammers, QCA.

Rebuilding Together Quad Cities is a non-profit organization supported entirely by contributions of time, labor, material and money. We are dedicated to repairing homes of those who, due to financial hardship, age, and/or disability, cannot do the work themselves. Skilled and unskilled volunteers complete the repairs at no cost to the homeowner.

To be eligible for participation in the program, you must own and live in your own home. Rebuilding Together Quad Cities policy does not allow working on mobile homes.

Volunteers provide improvements that enhance the safety and comfort of your home. Because it is primarily a one-day project, major structural repairs usually are not possible. Also, it is important that you understand that time and resources may prevent the volunteers from accomplishing everything that you would like to have done in your home.

All able-bodied residents of the home are expected to assist in making repairs.

Rebuilding Together Quad Cities workdays are scheduled each year during the spring and fall. To be considered for the program, complete the form and return it to Rebuilding Together Quad Cities as soon as possible. Your application must include the following:

- **A verification of amount and source of total annual income**
- **Proof of current homeowner's insurance policy**

Homes will be selected on the basis of greatest need **and** the ability of Rebuilding Together volunteers to accomplish the needed repairs. You will be notified in writing if your home is selected.
